Chief Tom Coppotelli:

- The department did sell the first police vehicle on e-bay and got \$1400 for it, we will be putting another used police vehicle on Facebook and a seized BMW SUV
- One of our officers had a scuffle after a DUI stop at Handi Mart and was drug with car, about 30 feet, officer received minor injuries and road rash but is back at work

Superintendent of Public Works

Brian Rader:

- 89th Street Project, storm sewers are in, still working on replacing 250 feet of drain pipes
- Lion's Club donated \$10,000 to the Village of Caseyville, Parks Department, and we are looking into exercise equipment with a roof over it, coverage from weather. There isn't much money in the Park operations, it's mostly donations and grants

Attorney:

Keyin Kaufhold:

- Sent letters to management of Handi Mart and the former Super Saver for back monies owed to the Village, could possible turn into real estate liens
- Met with a couple of hotels from south end and their attorney on improving relations between them and the Village. Next step would to bring the Chief of Police and the Zoning Administrator into the future meetings. It was a very positive meeting, pleasantly surprised. We will continue to meet regularly.
